## Re: Formal resolutions #3

Thank you for your letter outlining the following resolution. We appreciate the input we receive from the Ontario Soil and Crop Improvement Association (OSCIA) to help ensure Ontario producers get the support they need.

**Resolution #3 – Algoma & Cochrane OSCIA – Forage Production Insurance:** Be it resolved that OSCIA encourage Agricorp to modify hay insurance so that it is yield and quality based rather than relying on a rainfall only model.

Agricorp works with stakeholders and the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs (OMAFRA) to review and change coverage provided by Production Insurance. Priorities for change are determined with OMAFRA and require approval from both provincial and federal governments.

Rainfall based plans are used across North America to estimate hay and pasture yields and offer producers a simple and easy way to insure their forage. Ontario's forage insurance plan has been reviewed and updated several times based on stakeholder and customer feedback. Most recently in 2013, there were a number of enhancements made to the plan to make it more responsive. Some of those included updating the claim trigger to 85 per cent from 80 and adding minimum daily rainfall thresholds. The plan has paid over \$60 million to date, including the largest payouts in the driest years 2012, 2016 and 2020.

Agricorp is supporting an Agri-Risk project lead by the Canadian Cattlemen's Association and the Beef Farmers of Ontario. The primary focus of this feasibility study is to determine forage yields using satellite imagery. The feasibility study has been taking place in the Western provinces for a couple of growing seasons and is now continuing and being expanded to other provinces with the hope of producing sufficient robustness and accuracy of data. This type of research could help form the basis for a forage insurance program that is equal in concept to coverage available for annual crops.

This requires the ability to measure pasture production at the individual farm level. Agricorp will be collecting the samples and spectrometer readings from pasture locations in Ontario and providing expertise to the technical committee. The project is scheduled to run from May 2020 to August 2021.
