Interactive demonstrations on cover crops, direct seeded tree lot, soybean seeding rates and row spacing, tillage equipment displays, manure side dressed into corn, leaf hopper resistant varieties of Alfalfa, N calculator, Greenhouse Gas, and weed, insect and plant disease displays which promoted producer discussion with the Crop Tech specialists who were available for questions.

Next year's show will be held in Woodstock, Ontario on September 12, 13, & 14, 2006. There will be new field demonstrations and information displays so come and enjoy the show where "Farmers Meet".
