Purpose:

Grassy weeds are generally harder to identify in the field than broadleaf weeds especially at the growth stage when herbicide selection decisions are being made. Identification of grassy weeds at this stage are critical since many are highly selective when it comes to herbicide sensitivity. Correctly identifying grassy weed species is critical to designing an effective weed control program.

- Loss estimates of each grass species so that producers can determine their economic action level.
